(LOS ANGELES COUNTY)**

***Eight of eleven sectors posted year-over employment gains***

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Los Angeles County remained unchanged over the month to 5.1 percent in November 2016 from a revised 5.1 percent in October 2016 and was below the rate of 6.1 one year ago. Civilian employment remained unchanged to 4,881,000 in November 2016, while unemployment declined by 2,000 to 261,000 over the month. The civilian labor force decreased by 3,000 over the month to 5,141,000 in November 2016. (All of the above figures are seasonally adjusted.) The unadjusted unemployment rate for the county was 4.8 percent in November 2016.

The California seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.3 percent in November 2016, 5.5 percent in October 2016, and 5.9 percent a year ago in November 2015. The comparable estimates for the nation were 4.6 percent in November 2016, 4.9 percent in October 2016, and 5.0 percent a year ago.

**Between October 2016 and November 2016**, nonfarm employment in Los Angeles County increased by 22,200 to reach 4,418,000.

- Payrolls in trade, transportation, and utilities registered the largest month-over increase with an addition of 16,800 jobs. The holiday shopping season helped drive up the industry employment totals with an addition of 13,100 jobs in retail trade.
- Government employment levels registered a gain of 6,400 jobs that were most concentrated in the local government educational services subsector (up 3,100). Job levels in educational and health services were up by 1,200. Both public and private educational institutions increased their payrolls numbers as they finalized their seasonal hiring for the academic year.
- Construction employment reported a larger than normal seasonal decline of 1,800 jobs that was concentrated in specialty trade contractors (down 1,200).

**Between November 2015 and November 2016**, Los Angeles County nonfarm employment increased by 65,300 or 1.5 percent.

- Educational and health services reported the largest year-over expansion with an addition of 21,200 jobs. The majority of the job gains were in health care and social assistance (up 17,400), with private educational services adding 3,800 jobs to the overall increase.
- Payrolls in leisure and hospitality were augmented by 17,300. Accommodation and food services accounted for more than three-quarters of the increase with an addition of 13,400 jobs. Arts entertainment and recreation contributed the remaining total of 3,900 jobs to the growth.
- Government payrolls expanded by 13,500 over the year. Local government agencies accounted for the majority of the growth with a year-over addition of 9,500 jobs.

- Industries that reported year-over job declines included construction (down 4,400), manufacturing (down 4,200), and mining and logging (down 500).
