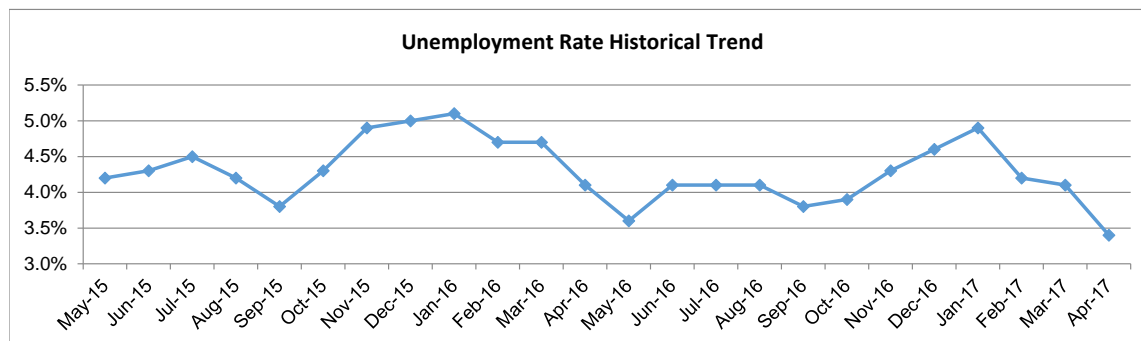


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 NAPA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Napa County)

The unemployment rate in the Napa County was 3.4 percent in April 2017, down from a revised 4.1 percent in March 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.5 percent for California and 4.1 percent for the nation during the same period.
