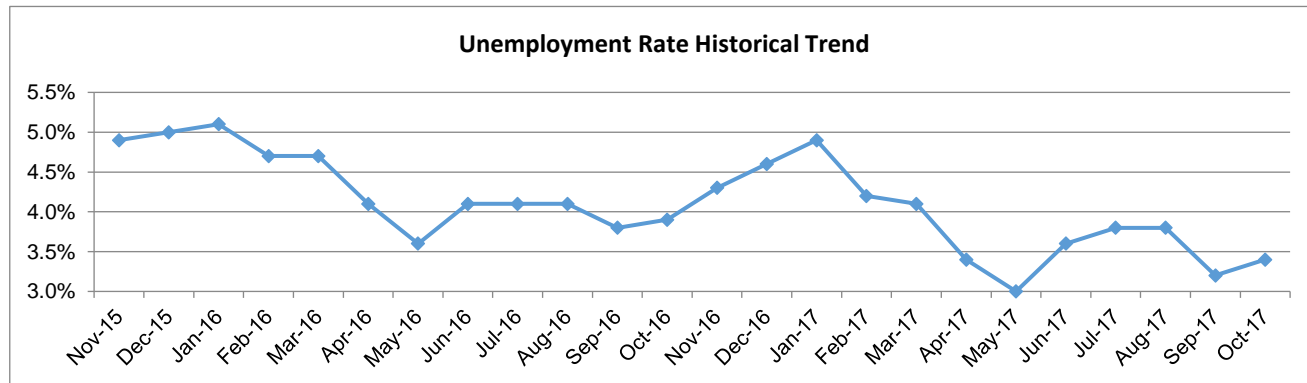


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 NAPA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Napa County)

The unemployment rate in the Napa County was 3.4 percent in October 2017, up from a revised 3.2 percent in September 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 3.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.3 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
