


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 NAPA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Napa County)

The unemployment rate in the Napa County was 4.2 percent in November 2016, up from a revised 3.8 percent in October 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 5.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.0 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
