Orange County gains 9,200 jobs over the month and 38,300 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Orange County was 3.7 percent in November 2016, down from a revised 4.1 percent in October 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.0 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between October 2016 and November 2016, total nonfarm wage and salary employment rose from 1,604,900 to 1,614,100, an increase of 9,200 jobs.


- Trade, transportation and utilities reported the largest month-over increase, adding 6,700 jobs. Normal seasonal gains in retail trade accounted for the majority of the increase (up 6,200 jobs). Transportation, warehousing and utilities reported a gain of 400 jobs and wholesale trade increased by 100 jobs.
- Professional and business services gained 2,200 jobs over the month. Administrative and support services, which includes temporary help firms, increased by 2,500 jobs. Management of companies and enterprises added 200 jobs, professional, scientific and technical services decline by 500 jobs, and waste management and remediation services remained unchanged.
- Construction reported the largest month-over employment decline (down 2,100 jobs). Other payroll losses occurred in financial activities (down 600 jobs), educational and health services (down 400 jobs), and manufacturing (down 200 jobs).

Between November 2015 and November 2016, total nonfarm wage and salary employment increased by 38,300 jobs, or 2.4 percent.

- Professional and business services led the year-over gain by adding 10,400 jobs. Sixty three percent of the increase was in administrative and support services, which added 6,500 jobs.
- Educational and health services added 9,100 jobs with over 83 percent of the increase in health care and social assistance (up 7,700 jobs). Educational services gained 1,400 jobs.
- Three industries reported year-over declines: manufacturing (down 500 jobs), financial activities (down 300 jobs) and mining and logging (down 100 jobs).
