

**RIVERSIDE-SAN BERNARDINO-ONTARIO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES)**

Nonfarm employment up 22,400 jobs over the month and up 34,100 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario MSA was 5.5 percent in November 2016, down from a revised 6.1 percent in October 2016, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.0 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 5.7 percent in Riverside County, and 5.3 percent in San Bernardino County.

Between October 2016 and November 2016, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,396,600 to 1,419,000 a gain of 22,400 jobs. Agricultural employment declined by 800 jobs.


- Trade, transportation, and utilities registered the greatest month-over gain, adding 12,100 jobs. Retail trade accounted for roughly 63 percent of the job growth in this sector (up 7,600), primarily from general merchandise stores (up 3,800) and clothing and clothing accessories stores (up 2,300). Transportation, warehousing, and utilities gained 4,600 jobs, while wholesale trade declined by 100 jobs.
- Six other sectors recorded month-over gains, including leisure and hospitality (up 3,300), government (up 2,500), and educational and health services (up 2,300).
- Professional and business services posted the only month-over job loss, down 100 jobs.
- Mining and logging, manufacturing, and information remained unchanged over the month.

Between November 2015 and November 2016, total nonfarm employment increased by 34,100 jobs, or 2.5 percent. Agricultural employment declined by 1,100 jobs over the year.

- Government registered the greatest year-over gain, adding 10,700 jobs. Local government (up 8,800) accounted for 82 percent of the job growth in this sector. State government added 1,600 jobs and federal government added 300 jobs over the year.
- Seven other sectors also added jobs over the year. The most notable job growth came from educational and health services (up 9,100), primarily from healthcare and social assistance (up 7,900). Educational services added 1,200 jobs over the year.
- Professional and business services reported the largest year-over loss, dropping by 1,400 jobs.
- Two other sectors also posted losses over the year: Mining and logging and leisure and hospitality lost 200 jobs each.
