

**SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA
(SAN DIEGO COUNTY)**

Nonfarm employment up 3,200 over the month; up 19,200 over the year

The unemployment rate in the San Diego County was 4.7 percent in August 2017, unchanged from a revised 4.7 percent in July 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.4 percent for California and 4.5 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between July 2017 and August 2017, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,441,000 to 1,444,200, a gain of 3,200 jobs. Agricultural employment remained unchanged over the month.

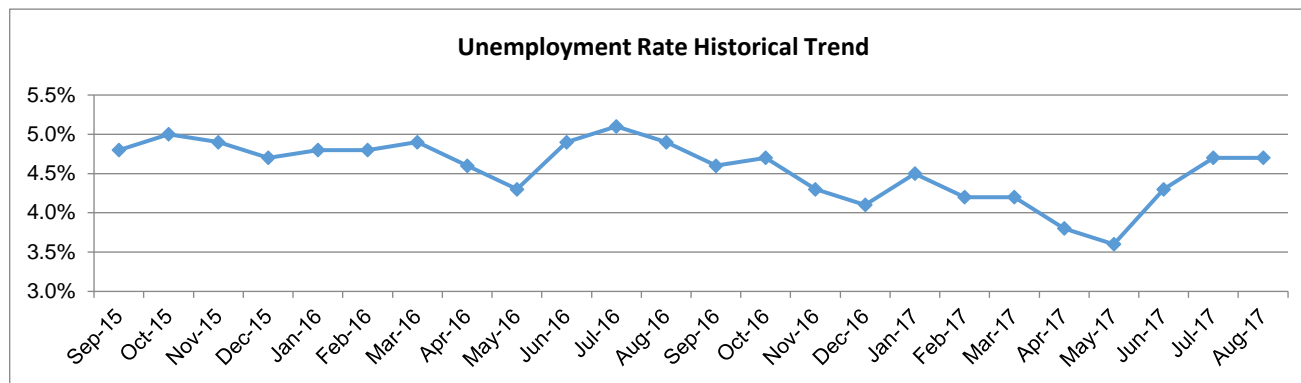
- The largest over the month job gain was reported in construction (up 1,200). Employment growth was prevalent in specialty trade contractors (up 900), followed by construction of buildings (up 300). Heavy and civil engineering construction remained unchanged.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities added 1,100 jobs. Job gains were concentrated in retail trade (up 1,300), and wholesale trade (up 500). Transportation and warehousing (down 600), and utilities (down 100), reduced payrolls over the month.
- Month-over job increases were noted in five other super sectors, including professional and business services (up 1,100), educational and health services (up 700), financial activities (up 500), other services (up 300), and information (up 100). Mining and logging remained unchanged.
- The largest job decrease was recorded in leisure and hospitality (down 1,000). Accommodation and food services (down 800), and arts, entertainment, and recreation (down 200), posted month-over losses. Government and manufacturing diminished jobs by 400 each.

Between August 2016 and August 2017, total nonfarm employment increased by 19,200 jobs, or 1.3 percent. Agricultural employment increased by 200 jobs or 2.2 percent.

- Educational and health services registered the largest year-over gain, adding 5,200 jobs. Health care and social assistance contributed with 5,600 jobs, while educational services decreased by 400 jobs.
- Six other super sectors recorded employment gains, with other services (up 5,000), government (up 4,900), and financial activities (up 2,900), reporting the largest year-over increase.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities and manufacturing reported job losses of 1,200 and 1,000 jobs respectively. Information and mining and logging remained unchanged over the year.
