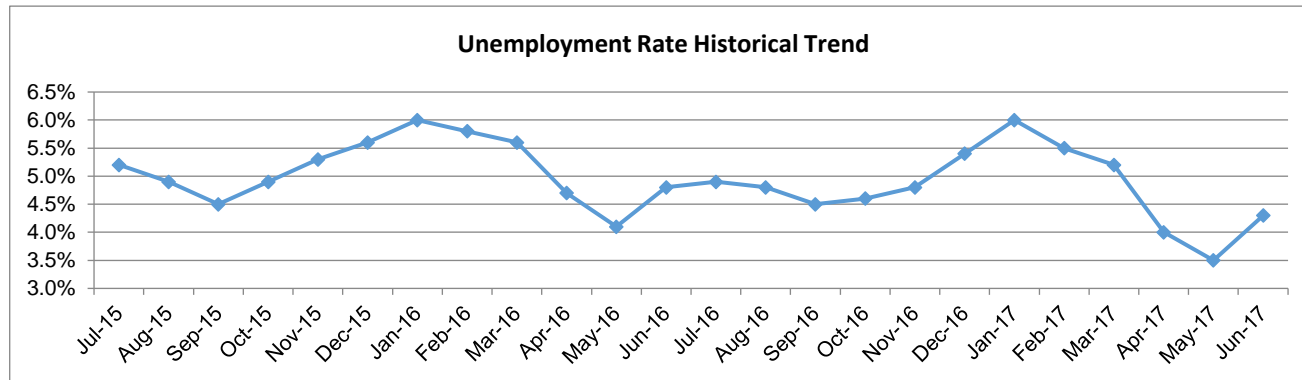


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 SANTA MARIA-SANTA BARBARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(Santa Barbara County)

The unemployment rate in the Santa Barbara County was 4.3 percent in June 2017, up from a revised 3.5 percent in May 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 4.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
