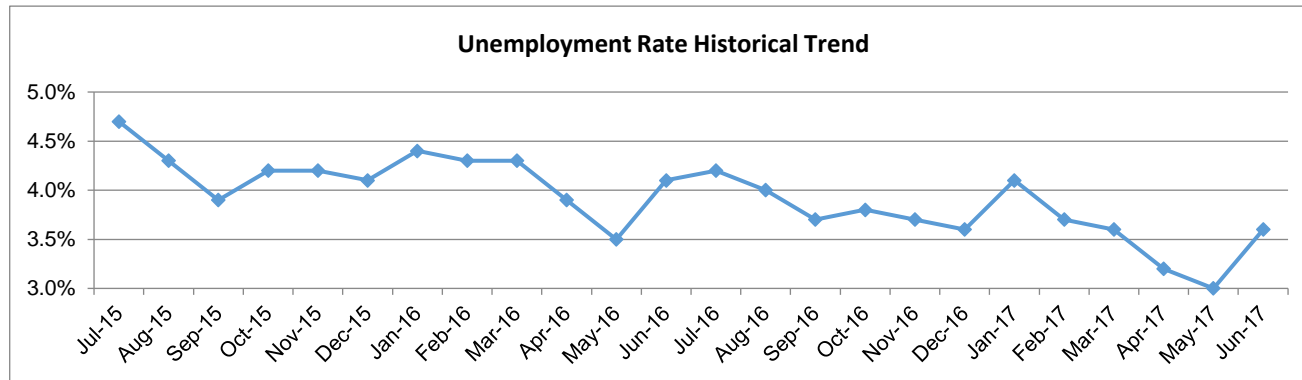


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 SANTA ROSA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Sonoma County)

The unemployment rate in the Sonoma County was 3.6 percent in June 2017, up from a revised 3.0 percent in May 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 4.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
