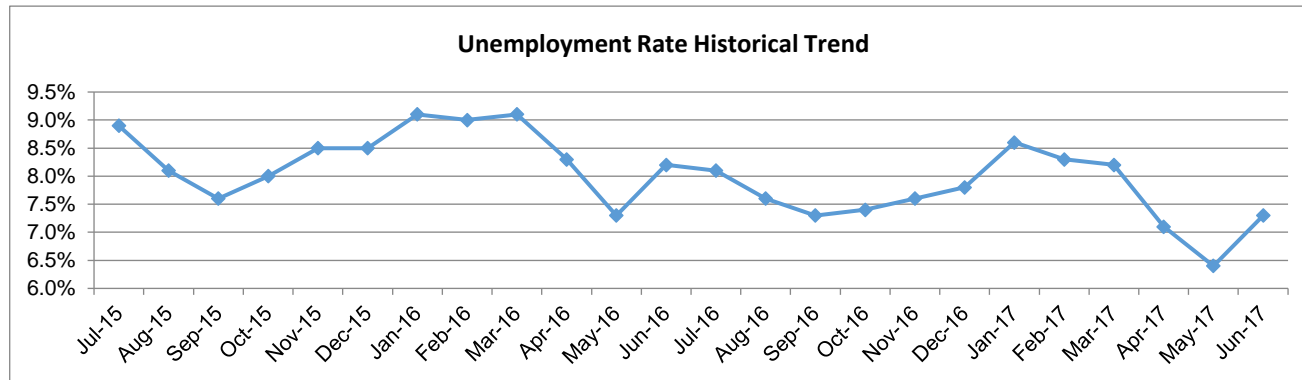


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 7.3 percent in June 2017, up from a revised 6.4 percent in May 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 4.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
